

2020-21 Youth Basketball Season COVID - 19 Guidelines & Rules Clearwater – Haysville - Mulvane

*** DEFINITION OF “SPECTATOR” = Any person or non-gametime player who enters a facility will count as ONE Spectator!** This means any non-playing gametime player (sibling who plays at later time or played at an earlier time) counts as a spectator, NOT a player. A player is ONLY a “Player” for their designated game time...when NOT playing he/she counts as a spectator. Thus, going to Clearwater or Mulvane, ONE parent will NOT be able to take two children at the same time unless the children are on the SAME TEAM. A different parent would have to take the other child at their game time or the other child will have to wait elsewhere. We apologize for the inconvenience but please be respectful and understanding of the rules set in place by the various school districts. We are fortunate to have access to their facilities so our youth can still continue to play the game they love!

* There will be no warm up basketballs provided by host site for games, each team is responsible for bringing their own basketballs to warm up with. *

IN CLEARWATER:

1. Only ONE (1) spectator per player allowed in the school facility for each game and must have on face covering.
2. Players can remove face coverings once they begin warm-ups for their game.
3. Team personnel will be on bleachers across gym from the score table.
4. Teams are NOT permitted into the gym until the previous game is over.

IN HAYSVILLE:

1. Only TWO (2) spectators per player are allowed on game days. Spectators will be required to wear masks and practice social distancing at all times.
2. Temperature checks will be administered at the door on game days at the Haysville Activity Center.
3. All patrons/players entering the building will be required to follow the HAC’s policies and wear a mask. The player may remove their mask once their team has begun warm-ups for their game.
4. All spectators must remain seated on the bleachers during games. No spectators will be allowed to stand in open gym areas, along the sidelines or around the walking track.
5. All spectators must exit the building once their child’s game has ended. No congregating in the lobby or hallways following the games. It is recommended that vulnerable populations remain home.
6. Teams are asked to arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before their game time.

IN MULVANE:

1. Only ONE (1) spectator per player allowed in the MRC facility for each game.
2. Everyone is required to wear a mask at all times, players can remove their mask once they begin warm-ups for their game.
3. All spectators must be seated during games, standing in open areas or on the sidelines is not permissible.
4. All spectators must exit the building once their game has ended. No congregating in the lobby or hallways following the games. Vulnerable populations should be asked to stay home.
5. Teams are asked to arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before their game time.

*** Failure to comply with the individual site safety guidelines will result in dismissal from the facility. ***
